It is routine policy in this practice to heat sterilise (Autoclave) handpieces and instruments after each patient, in accordance with the latest guidelines from the Department of Health. We make extensive use of disposable products where ever possible.

We accept cheques, cash and most leading credit / debit cards

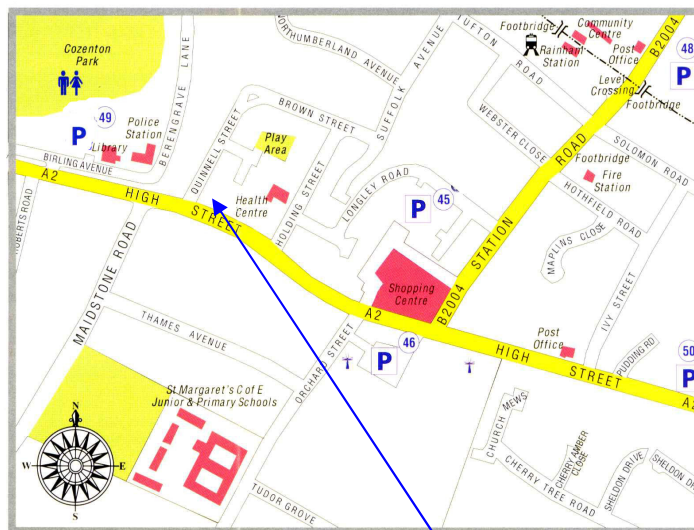


### Dental Care Products

### Nurses

All our dental nurses are trained (or in training) and registered with the appropriate authority. Several nurses are qualified to take x-rays on behalf of the prescribing dentist.

### Receptionists

Our receptionists will welcome you to the Practice and help answer any queries you may have. Questions of a clinical nature will always be discussed with your dental practitioner if appropriate.

### Continuing Professional Development

All dentists, hygienists and staff undertake regular further training to update their knowledge and skills.

### Facilities

The reception area and five modern well equipped surgeries are fully air conditioned for your comfort. The two downstairs surgeries are suitable for wheelchair access.

### Treatment

We provide quality care for adult patients on a private basis. A wide range of up-to-date techniques is available. Your dentist will discuss appropriate treatment options with you. You will be provided with an estimate of the cost (written upon request).

### Prevention

This begins with our comprehensive examination which includes oral cancer screening, assessment of your teeth and gum health and advice on prevention. Our hygienists play an important role in the prevention and treatment of gum problems. Regular examinations in accordance with the National Institute of Clinical Excellence (NICE) guidelines are encouraged. Postal reminders will be sent to you.

### Specialist Gum & Dental Implant Services

Dr Craig Kennett offers a specialist periodontal service for the treatment of advanced gum problems. Dr Kennett and Dr Amanda-Jane Rogers both provide Implants to replace missing teeth within the practice (on referral). Please ask for further details.

### Cosmetic & Restorative Dentistry

If any aspect of your dental appearance concerns you, no matter how trivial, please discuss it with your dentists. Modern dentistry offers exciting possibilities such as tooth coloured fillings, porcelain veneers, tooth whitening, crowns, gum recontouring and implants. Just ask!



### Orthodontics

Children requiring orthodontics (for straightening teeth) can if appropriate be referred for joint treatment with local specialist NHS orthodontic practitioners after discussion with the patient. Orthodontic treatment for adults, or child patients not available within the NHS, can be provided on a private basis within the Practice by Dr Christopher Gould (who limits his practice to orthodontic treatment only).

## Children!

Due to radical changes introduced by the Government in April 2006 provision of NHS treatment to children (under 18 years)

has had to be restricted. Limited numbers of new child patients are accepted for treatment within the NHS as and when spaces become available.

### NHS or Private care for children?

When no NHS children's spaces are available, or at the parents preference, new child patients can be treated on a private basis only, with a reduced charge for examinations. Private treatment fees for children are at reduced charge and generally relate to the time taken to provide the work needed. (Details available from Reception). Private treatment enables us to offer a greater range of preventative care, including the option of the application of sealants to back teeth, dietary advice and tooth coloured fillings on permanent teeth where appropriate.

The Practice does not currently offer insurance based schemes for adult or child care. We feel that these prove to be expensive for the patient as inevitably the costs for consumer advertising, glossy brochures and scheme administration come directly from the patients' monthly payments.

Children are always welcome - however young they are. We aim to prevent dental disease rather than treat it at a later date.

### Anxious?

Some people feel a deep seated anxiety about dentistry. We understand. Please discuss your fears with us and we will do everything to help. Slightly longer appointments so you don't feel rushed and the limited use of oral sedation are some of the ways we help you to help yourself.
